## **ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY**

Remember in your **ARGUMENTATIVE ESSAY** you are supposed to give a **balanced point of view** on your topic, and it should be divided in **four paragraphs**:

An **introduction** or **opening** made up of a **hook**, followed by a description of the **background situation**(paint a picture of the world) and a **thesis statement**.

A main body in which your points for and against, using a topic sentence along with the justification(supporting evidence), appear in two separate paragraphs.

A conclusion or closing in which you summarize your main points, give your opinion and add some "food for thought".
