OPINION ESSAY

Remember in your **OPINION ESSAY** you are supposed to give **your opinion** on a specific topic and **support** it, and it should be divided in **three paragraphs**:

An **introduction** or **opening** made up of a **hook**, followed by a description of the **background situation**(paint a picture of the world) and a **thesis statement** in which you **opinion** must be **clearly stated**. (On what side are you?)

A main body in which you need to support your position, using a topic sentence along with the justification (supporting evidence). You might even consider the counterarguments.

A conclusion or closing in which you summarize your main points, restate your position and add some "food for thought".
